#### Purpose

This purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines when selecting coaches for Provincial teams.

#### Qualifications

1. Must have completed the current **Respect in Sport** training program and registered in Sport Manitoba data base.
2. Must have a current Police Clearance
3. Must be certified at a minimum level 2 National Coaching Certificate Program (NCCP)
4. Must have minimum Level 2 Cricket Canada Certification
5. Have played cricket at a high level in a Test Playing Country or have represented an ICC Associate member at multiple ICC sponsored events.
6. As an alternate to 5 above, represented Canada at the International stage or represented Manitoba for more than 10 years at National Championships
7. Must have demonstrated to MCA members, a satisfactory ability to Lead, Analyze skills, Manage Performance and Conduct Effective Training Sessions.

#### Responsibilities Pre Tournament

1. Must be a member in good standing and not under suspension or under investigation by his club or the MCA

2. In preparation for an upcoming tour, must be available to conduct practice sessions a minimum of two sessions a week until the tournament is over
3. Serve as one member of the Selection Panel when the final team is selected.
4. Manage all training sessions, equipment and injuries on an ongoing basis

### **Responsibilities on Tour**

5. Establish and implement objectives both short and long term.
6. Communicate and relate well with players and other team management
7. Attend all tournament meetings to gather information on tournament rules, player expectations and any other important information to help the team succeed
8. Prior to each session of play, the coach is responsible for advising each team member in areas such as batting, bowling, fielding and handling game tactics etc.
9. During each session of play the coach shall offer his/her assistance to the captain in areas of batting order and tactics for the game.
10. Observe play during the matches, make notes and present them at post-game discussions
11. Assist the manager where necessary
12. Establish and implement a supportable code of conduct
13. Look after necessary medical, physio needs of players (unless physio/trainer has that job)
14. Provide a full report to the MCA after the tour including recommendation to improve specific player performance and needs.
